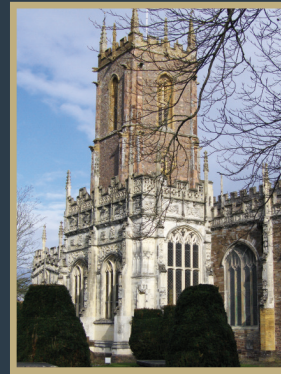

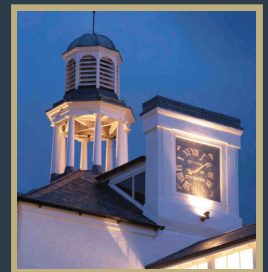

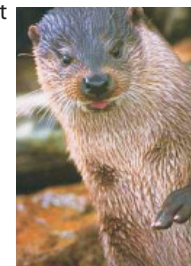
The Market building is host to a variety of themed markets, so why not come along and see what's happening?
