* IT IS THE COMPANY'S PREFERENCE THAT ALL CHILDREN AGED 13 TO 17 YEARS WEAR LIFE JACKETS. BUT, IF IT IS CONSIDERED BY THE PARENT/GUARDIAN THAT THE CHILD CAN SWIM 25 METRES OR MORE, THE PARENT/GUARDIAN CAN ON BEHALF OF THE CHILD, OPT OUT OF THE LIFE JACKET, HOWEVER BY OPTING OUT THEY ACCEPT AN INCREASED RISK IN THE SAFETY OF THE CHILD.
